Horse on Course Equitation Derby

This class is open to all Junior and Amateur riders on horses and ponies. **The Class will be run as an Add-back class.** \$15.00 per entry will be added to the prize purse. Purse will be distributed as follows; 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%.

The class will be conducted as a two-phase equitation class. All entries will first compete over an equitation type course of at least (8) fences. The top (8) riders will be invited back to participate in the flat phase of the competition. All riders will be asked to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. At the judge's discretion, additional testing may be requested. Entries will be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount.

All entries may choose between fence heights 2'3", 2'6" or 2'9" (please declare fence height on entry form). Heights judged and pinned together. Exclusive ribbons will be awarded through eighth place.

Class: 500 Entry Fee \$35.00

An embroidered saddle pad will be awarded to the top (2) winners.

Horse on Course Jumper Mini-Prix

The class is open to all Junior and Amateur riders on horses and ponies. **The Class will be run as an Add-back class.** \$15.00 per entry will be added to the prize purse. Purse will be distributed as follows; 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%.

All entries must compete in at least TWO jumper classes at each show prior to the Jumper Mini-Prix. Fences will be set at 2'6" to 2'9", with spreads not to exceed fence heights. Class to be run under Table II 2(d). The top (8) horses will return for the jump off. Exclusive ribbons will be awarded through eighth place.

Class: 105 Entry Fee \$35.00

An embroidered saddle pad will be awarded to the top (2) winners.

Horse on Course RAFFLE

Each exhibitor will be eligible to enter a drawing to win a FREE stall or a FREE division at a future schooling show. Be sure to ask for details at the Horse Show Office.

Entries

Entries will close on the Monday before each show. Post entries will be accepted the day of the show at regular cost. Pre-entry blanks will only be accepted when signed appropriately and accompanied by a check for stabling fees. All horses/ponies entered must show proof of negative Coggins test before entry will be accepted. Likewise, all non-showing horses brought to the show facility must show proof of negative Coggins test to the show secretary upon arrival. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order.

Fees for Hunter Classes: \$12.00 per class; unless otherwise specified.

Fees for Jumper Classes: \$15.00 per class; unless otherwise specified.

Fees for Leadline: \$10.00.

Stabling

10x10 permanent wood stalls with door in permanent barn. 10x10 wooden outdoor stalls with doors. Stabling will be available at \$70.00/weekend if pre-paid. The charge will be \$85.00 if not received by Monday of the show week. Weekend stabling has priority over day stabling. Day stabling, if available, will be charged at \$35.00 per day, and overnight will be charged \$50.00 per night. Bedding will be available for purchase at \$8.00/bag. Requests for bedding should be included on your entry form. **STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE HELD WITHOUT PAYMENT.** Stall fees are not refundable. A grounds fee of \$20.00 per horse will be charged to all day shippers whether showing or not. A special area will be designated, and all day shippers must check in at show office immediately upon arrival at the farm. Reservations and fees must be received no later than Monday of the show week. Stalls will be available the Friday before the show at 12:00NOON.

Schooling

Schooling will be permitted on Friday from noon until 8:00 PM. On Saturday from the conclusion of the show until 8:00 PM. Show rings will close 30 minutes prior to the start of each show day. Management reserves the right to vary this schedule. Closed schooling sessions will be available for all walk-trot riders prior to each division. Please refer to the class schedule.

Credentials

No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. Any Children's Pony Hunter must have size checked on entry blank.

Refunds

No stall fees will be refunded. No class fees will be refunded unless the class is cancelled or with a veterinarian's certificate.

Management

The horse show management reserves the right to itself to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors and to prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Hunter Classes

All Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field, such as, but not limited to: brush, wall, oxer, post and rails, gate and panels. All equitation classes will be judged on seat, hands, and guidance and control of the mount.

Jumper Classes

Courses in the Jumper sections may consist of any combination of the following: brush, oxers, post and rails, liverpool, walls, panels and coops. In the event of a tie in any placing, the tie shall be broken by time taken in the first round. All Jumper classes will be run under Table II, Section 2b. Management reserves the right to change any table or height (within the division rules) to accommodate conditions or competitors showing.

Jumping Order

A rotating jumping order may be established for all classes over fences. Management reserves the right to draw and post an order of go. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class please see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

Prizes

Six ribbons will be presented in all classes, unless otherwise stated.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be presented to two of the top four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only those horses will receive full points for one under saddle class.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to the two horses that have acquired the most points in each jumper section.

PLEASE NOTE

- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. **Dogs are not permitted in the show office or concession area.**
- **No Smoking** permitted inside main building or around stabling areas.
- No alterations are to be made to the permanent stabling or other facilities by exhibitors.
- A processing fee of \$25.00 plus collection fees will be charged for any non-negotiable checks.
- All riders must wear protective headgear while mounted.
- All riders must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the ring.
- Show ring is, 125x250 sand/clay footing.
- Schooling Ring I is, 120x200 sand footing.
- All horses brought to the facility (whether showing or not) are responsible for providing the show office with a signed entry form, current Coggins and payment of the EMT and Grounds Fees.
- Concession will be available throughout the horse show.

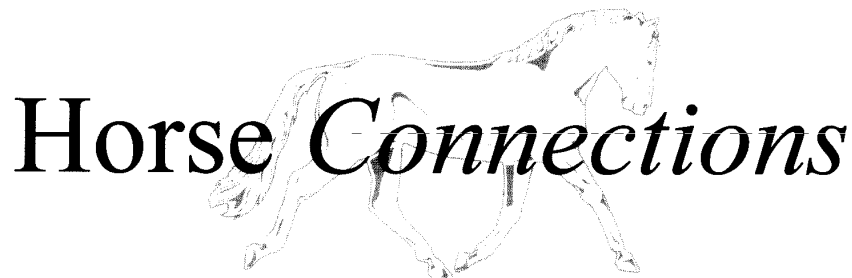

Hunter Divisions

Special Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders regardless of age or status. To be judged on performance and soundness. (Fences 2'3")

Classes: 4,5 Special Hunter Over Fences
6 Special Hunter Under Saddle

Very Green Hunter

Open to horses with limited experience in their FIRST or SECOND year of showing. To be judged on performance and soundness. (Fences 2'3")

Classes: 7,8 Very Green Hunter Over Fences
9 Very Green Hunter Under Saddle

Hopeful Hunter

Open to horses with limited show experience. To be judged on performance and soundness. (Fences 2'3"-2'6")

Classes: 10,11 Hopeful Hunter Over Fences
12 Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle

Pre-Green Hunter

Open to horses that have never shown over fences higher than 3' at USEF recognized shows. Horses are eligible in this section for awards for two years only and are no longer eligible for Very Green. May cross enter into Open, Adult Amateur, or Children's Hunter. (Fences 2'9")

Classes: 13,14 Pre-Green Hunter Over Fences
15 Pre-Green Hunter Under Saddle

Open Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders regardless of age or status. To be judged on performance and soundness. (Choice of fence height 2'6", 2'9", 3')

Classes: 16,17 Open Hunter Over Fences
18 Open Hunter Under Saddle

Adult Amateur Hunter Divisions

Low Adult Hunter

Open to Amateur riders 18 years and older. Ponies may be shown by adults, suitability to count. May cross enter into Low Intermediate and Intermediate Hunter. (Fences 2'3")

Classes: 19,20 Low Adult Hunter Over Fences
21 Low Adult Hunter Under Saddle

Novice Amateur (MHJA Adult)

Open to Amateur riders. May cross-enter into Intermediate Hunter, Low Adult, Low Intermediate, or Adult Amateur. (Fences 2'6")

Classes: 22,23 Novice Amateur Hunter Over Fences
24 Novice Amateur Hunter Under Saddle

Adult Amateur Hunter

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. May cross enter into MHJA Adult, Intermediate and Open. Ponies may be shown by adults, suitability to count. Horses may be jogged for soundness at the discretion of the judge. (Fences 2'9")

Classes: 25,26 Adult Amateur Hunter Over Fences
27 Adult Amateur Hunter Under Saddle

Children's Hunter Divisions

Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders 12 years of age and under with limited experience. May cross enter into Beginner Rider and Low Intermediate. (Fences 18"-2')

Classes: 28,29 Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences
30 Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

Pre-Children's Hunter

Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance. May cross enter into Low Intermediate, Intermediate and Low Children's Hunter. (Fences 2'3")

Classes: 31,32 Pre-Children's Hunter Over Fences
33 Pre-Children's Hunter Under Saddle

Low Children's Hunter

Open to Junior riders who have not shown in a division with fence heights over 2'9". May cross enter into Low Intermediate, Pre-Children's, Children's Hunter (Horse), Children's Pony (if eligible) Open and Intermediate. (Fences 2'6")

Classes: 37,38 Low Children's Hunter Over Fences
39 Low Children's Hunter Under Saddle

Children's Hunter

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden by a Junior exhibitor. To be judged on performance and soundness. May cross enter into Intermediate Hunter, Low Children's and Open. (Fences 2'9" for horses, 2'6" for large ponies, 2' 3" for medium ponies and 2' for small ponies)

Classes: 40,41 Children's Hunter Over Fences
42 Children's Hunter Under Saddle

Hunter Rider Divisions

Limit Rider Hunter

Open to Juniors and Amateurs on horses or ponies with very limited experience. Riders may trot OR canter a course of eight fences at 18". Fences will not contain any flowers, walls or gates. May not cross enter into any other division.

Long Stirrup Rider Hunter

Open to riders 13 years of age and over with very limited experience. May cross enter into Beginner Rider and Low Intermediate. (Fences 18"-2')

48 Long Stirrup Rider Hunter Under Saddle

Beginner Rider Hunter

Open to horses and ponies being ridden by Juniors and Amateurs with limited experience. May cross enter into Low Intermediate, Short Stirrup and Long Stirrup. (Fences 18"-2')

Classes: 49,50 Beginner Rider Hunter Over Fences
51 Beginner Rider Hunter Under Saddle

Low Intermediate Rider Hunter

Open to Junior and Amateurs on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance. Juniors may cross enter into Short/Long Stirrup, Beginner Rider, Pre-Children's, Low Children's, Intermediate; or if a small or medium pony, Children's Hunter Pony. Amateurs may cross enter into Beginner Rider, Long Stirrup, Low Adult, Novice Amateur or Intermediate. (Fences 2'3")

Classes: 52,53 Low Intermediate Hunter Over Fences
54 Low Intermediate Hunter Under Saddle

Intermediate Rider Hunter

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged on performance. Juniors may cross enter into Low Intermediate, Pre-Children's, Low Children's, Children's Pony Hunter, or Children's Hunter. Amateurs may cross enter into Low Intermediate, Low Adult or Novice Amateur. (Fences 2'6")

Classes: 55,56 Intermediate Rider Hunter Over Fences
57 Intermediate Rider Hunter Under Saddle

Walk-Trot Divisions

Leadline (class will take place during the course change before the walk-trot classes)

Open to riders (7) years of age and under. To be judged on manners and suitability of pony to rider 50% and horsemanship 50%. Riders must be led by a handler. **Entry fee: \$10.00.**

Walk-Trot Ground Rails

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Walk-Trot Ground Rails entries will trot a course of eight ground rails, twice around the outside. May not cross enter into any other division.

64 Walk-Trot Ground Rails Under Saddle

Walk-Trot Cross Rails

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders will trot a course of eight cross rails at 12", twice around the outside. May not cross enter into any other division.

Classes: 67,68 Walk-Trot Cross Rails (Section A)
69 Walk-Trot Under Saddle (Section A)

Walk-Trot-Canter Cross Rails

Open to Beginner riders only. Walk-Trot-Canter Cross Rails entries will ride a course of eight cross rails at 12", twice around the outside. Riders may canter OR trot into the lines and canter out, with consistency strongly emphasized.

Jumper Divisions

Novice Jumper Division

Open to all horses and riders with VERY limited experience. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Beginner Jumper. (Fences 2')

Beginner Jumper

Open to all horses and riders with very limited experience. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Hopeful Jumper. (Fences 2'6")

Classes: 90,91 Beginner Jumper Table II 2b

Hopeful Jumper

Open to all horses and riders. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Beginner Jumper and Training Jumper. (Fences 2'9")

Classes: 93,94 Hopeful Jumper Table II 2b

Training Jumper

Open to all horses and riders. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Hopeful Jumper and Schooling Jumper. (Fences 3')
