Hunter Rider Divisions

Walk-Trot Hunter Division

Open to beginner riders only with very limited experience. If the class size is excessive, then classes may be split, based on rider's age, into 8 years and under and 9 years and over. Riders to walk and trot both ways of the ring. Manners, way of going and suitability of rider to mount to be judged. Cross-rails not to exceed 12" in height.

Riders may not cross enter into any other division. **Entry fee \$10.00 per class.**

48 Walk-Trot Equitation Over Fences
49 Walk-Trot Hunter Under Saddle
50 Walk-Trot Equitation on the Flat

Children's Hunter Divisions

Children's Pony Hunter Division

To be shown by Junior exhibitors. Judged on manners and suitability. May cross enter into Intermediate, or if eligible, Very Green. Small and medium ponies may cross enter into Low Intermediate. (Fences 2'3" for small and medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies)

Classes: 22, 23 Children's Pony Hunter Over Fences
24 Children's Pony Hunter Under Saddle

Children's Hunter Division

To be shown by Junior exhibitors. To be judged on performance and soundness. May cross enter into Intermediate, Open, or if eligible, Very Green Hunter. (Fences 2'9")

Classes: 25, 26 Children's Hunter Over Fences
27 Children's Hunter Under Saddle

Short Stirrup Hunter Division

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. May cross enter into Beginner Rider and Low Intermediate. (Fences 18" - 2')

Classes: 28, 29 Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences
30 Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

If the weather cooperates, the show will be held outdoors. If lack of daylight and footing conditions are not favorable the show will moved indoors. Please visit our website for any updates regarding show venue. If the show is held outdoors all schooling breaks in the schedule will be eliminated with the exception of the break before the Walk-Trot Cross Rails Division.

Schooling Hunter Division

of negative Coggins test before entry will be accepted. Likewise, all non-showing horses brought to the show facility must show proof of negative Coggins test to the show secretary upon arrival. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order.

Fees for Hunter Sections: \$12.00 individual class; \$30.00 per division

Fees for Jumper Sections: \$15.00 per class

Stabling

10x10 permanent wood stalls with door in permanent barn. 10x10 wooden outdoor stalls with doors. Stabling will be available at \$70.00/weekend, if pre-paid. The charge will be \$85.00 if fees are not received by Monday of the show week. Stalls in the show barn will fill first unless outdoor stalls are requested. Weekend stabling has priority over day stabling. Day stabling, if available, will be charged at \$35.00 per day/\$50.00 per night. Bedding will be available for purchase at \$6.50/bag. Requests for bedding should be included on your entry form. **STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE HELD WITHOUT PAYMENT.** Stall fees are not refundable. Reservations and fees must be received no later than Monday of the show week. Stalls will be available on Friday after 12:00NOON. Please call **DYANN** to confirm stall reservations 724-352-5366.

A Day Shipper fee of \$10.00 will be charged to all entries showing off their trailer. A special area will be designated for day shippers.

Credentials

No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. Any Pony Hunter must have size checked on entry blank.

Refunds

No stall fees will be refunded. No class fees will be refunded unless the class is cancelled or with a veterinarian's certificate.

Parking

Please follow designated parking patterns and posted signs. Wet ground conditions may prohibit or limit parking on all areas of the show grounds. In an effort to keep the show grounds safe and accessible at all times we ask that you cooperate with the show staff and follow all designated parking patterns. **A special area will be designated for those showing off their trailer.**

Academy Classes

Walk-Trot-Canter Rider Division

Open to all riders with VERY limited experience. Fences will be 2'. No oxers. Simple changes of lead will not be penalized. May not cross enter into any other division.

52 Walk-Trot-Canter Eq. O/F
53 Walk-Trot-Canter Eq. on the Flat

Jumper Divisions

Novice Jumper Division

Open to all horses and riders with VERY limited experience. Fences will be 2' with spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Beginner Jumper.

Classes: 54, 55, 56 Novice Jumper

Beginner Jumper Division

Open to all horses and riders with very limited experience. Fences will be 2'6" with spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Hopeful Jumper.

Classes: 57, 58, 59 Beginner Jumper

Hopeful Jumper Division

Open to all horses and riders. Fences will be 2'6" – 2'9" with spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Beginner Jumper and Low Training Jumper.

Classes: 60, 61, 62 Hopeful Jumper

Low Training Jumper Division

Open to all horses and riders. Fences will be 2'9" – 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Hopeful Jumper and High Training Jumper.

Classes: 63, 64, 65 Low Training Jumper

Schooling Jumper Division

Open to all horses and riders. Fences will be 3'3" – 3'6" with spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Hopeful Jumper and Low Training Jumper.

Classes: 66, 67 Schooling Jumper

Management

The horse show management reserves the right to itself to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors and to prohibit exhibition of entries, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Class Descriptions

All Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field, such as, but not limited to: brush, wall, oxer, post and rails, gate and panels.

Courses in the Jumper sections may consist of any combination of the following: brush, oxers, post and rails, liverpool, walls, panels and coops. In the event of a tie in any placing, the tie shall be broken by time taken in the first round. All Jumper classes will be run under Table II, Section 2b. Management reserves the right to change any table or height (within the division rules) to accommodate conditions or competitors showing.

Jumping Order

A rotating jumping order may be established for all classes over fences. Management reserves the right to draw and post an order of go. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class please see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

Prizes

Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the top four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only those horses will receive full points for one under saddle class. A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to the two horses that have acquired the most points in each jumper section.

Schooling

Schooling will be permitted in the show ring before and after each show day. Show ring will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the show. A 15-minute closed schooling session will be available for all walk-trot riders prior to the division. An outdoor schooling area will be available and designated as such, weather and conditions permitting.

Hunter Rider Divisions

Low Intermediate Hunter Division

Open to Juniors and Amateurs on horses or ponies. Juniors may cross enter into Beginner Rider, Short/Long Stirrup, Intermediate; or if a small or medium pony, Children's Pony Hunter. Amateurs may cross enter into Beginner Rider, Low Adult, Long Stirrup, Novice Amateur or Intermediate. (Fences 2'3")

Classes: 31, 32 Low Intermediate Hunter Over Fences
33 Low Intermediate Hunter Under Saddle

Intermediate Hunter Division

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. Juniors may cross enter into Low Intermediate, Children's Pony Hunter or Children's Hunter. Amateurs may cross enter into Low Intermediate, Novice Amateur and Low Adult. (Fences 2'6")

Classes: 34, 35 Intermediate Hunter Over Fences
36 Intermediate Hunter Under Saddle

Beginner Rider Hunter Division

Open to horses and ponies being ridden by Juniors and Amateurs with limited experience. May cross enter into Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup and Low Intermediate. (Fences 18" -2')

Classes: 37, 38 Beginner Rider Hunter Over Fences
39 Beginner Rider Hunter Under Saddle

Long Stirrup Hunter Division

Open to riders 13 years of age and over with very limited experience. May cross enter into Low Intermediate and Beginner Rider. (Fences 18" - 2')

Classes: 40, 41 Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences
42 Long Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

Leadline

Open to riders (7) years of age and under. To be judged on manners and suitability of pony to rider 50% and horsemanship of rider 50%. Riders may not cross enter into any other division. Riders must be led by a handler. **Entry fee \$10.00.**

Classes: 43 Leadline

Walk Hunter Division

Open to riders (8) years and under that are in their first year of showing. Riders may not be accompanied by a handler. Riders to walk both ways of the ring. May not cross enter into any other division.

Classes: 44 Walk Equitation on the Flat
45 Walk Hunter Under Saddle

Please Note

- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. **Dogs are not permitted in the show office, indoor viewing area or concession area.**
- **No Smoking** permitted inside main building or around stabling areas.
- No alterations are to be made to the permanent stabling or other facilities by exhibitors.
- A processing fee of \$25.00 plus collection fees will be charged for any non-negotiable checks.
- All riders must wear protective headgear while mounted.
- All riders must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the ring.
- If the show is held indoors, an outdoor schooling area will be available and designated as such, weather and conditions permitting. The class schedule will allow for schooling breaks throughout the show day.
- If the show is held indoors, an area inside the arena will be designated for spectators. Seating will not be provided.
- All horses brought to the facility (whether showing or not) are responsible for providing the show office with a signed entry form, current Coggins and payment of the Grounds Fee.
- Randia's Grill will be serving delicious home-made food throughout the horse show.
