



# FRANK MADDEN CLINIC

## APRIL 19-20, 2008

We are excited to announce that Frank Madden will be conducting a two-day clinic at Horse On Course Equestrian Center April 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>, 2008. There will be three sessions offered each day. Each session will be two hours long. Space in these sessions will be limited. Session One will be set at 2'6", Session Two will be set at 2'9"-3' and Session Three will be set at 3'3"-3'6". Riders should be comfortable jumping the height of the session that he or she chooses and they must **PLEASE** be on time for their selection session. The clinic is to be held outdoors weather permitting. Should the weather be inclement the clinic will move indoors.

Spaces for each session will be offered on a first come, first serve basis. Preference will be given to those wishing to participate in both days of the clinic. Individuals wishing to participate in a single session will be put on a waiting list and notified if there are any spaces left. The price for one session is \$225 and two sessions is \$425.

**No application will be accepted without a 50% deposit**, which will be refundable only upon cancellation of the clinic or with a written excuse from a veterinarian up to two weeks prior to the clinic. **Full Payment** for the clinic and stabling is due **by April 7th**.

**\*\*Each horse must have a current negative Coggins test to be shown at the registration tent upon entering the facility. No horse will be permitted in the stabling area until proof of negative Coggins is shown.\*\***

Pre-Registered auditors will be accepted at \$45 per day and \$85 for two days. Walk-in auditors will be accepted at \$55 per day and \$95 dollars for two days. **Everyone** interested in observing the clinic, excluding participants, **must** pay the auditor's fee. No exceptions will be made. Each rider may have one auditor free. We ask that all auditors be courteous and respectful to fellow auditors, the clinician and all clinic participants. As such, we ask that there be no flash photography and that all cell phones be silenced while a session is in progress.

**\*\*Wristbands** distinguishing riders and auditors will be distributed at the registration tent and **must** be worn throughout the duration of the clinic. **\*\***

**DOGS**: No dogs on a leash or otherwise will be permitted in any arena or the boarders barn at any time. Dogs should be kept on a leash and away from horse and pedestrian traffic.

**STABLING**: Stabling will be available from Friday at 12:00pm – Sunday at 7:00pm. Stalls are 10x11. Stalls are \$35 per day, \$50.00 overnight and \$70.00 for the weekend. Tack stalls will be available at \$35 per day. Shavings may be purchased at the facility for \$6.50 per bag. Also, a stall deposit fee of \$20.00 is requested and will only be deposited if stall is not stripped upon departure.

**PARKING**: A parking attendant will direct visitors to the facility Friday through Sunday. Please be respectful of other vehicles and give horses the "Right of Way." Trailers will be permitted to park next to the stable area to unload. After unloading all trailers are to be parked in the designated "Parking Field." Vehicle parking will be available next to the stable areas throughout the weekend on a first come, first serve basis.

**FOOD AND BEVERAGE**: Randita's Café will be serving breakfast, lunch and dinner Saturday and Sunday from 7:00am to 5:00pm.

**ATTIRE**: All clinic participants are to be appropriately attired. As equitation is part of the clinic, please no loose or flapping clothing, this includes "hoodies" of any sort. Jackets and vests, if worn are to be zipped.

Proper headgear is required for **all** riders in all sessions. All riders are to wear britches and boots. Tack should be clean and fitted properly. Horses should be clean and properly prepared for the clinic. Horses are permitted to wear schooling boots including bell boots for the clinic.

**BARN HOURS:** The facility will open at 12:00pm on Friday April 18 and remain open until 9:00pm for horses and riders arriving for the clinic. Schooling in the various arenas will be available to riders on Friday, April 18 from 12:00pm until 7:00pm. Saturday the facility will open at 6:00am and close at 9:00pm. Sunday the facility will open at 6:00am and close at 7:00pm.

**LUNGING:** Please be sure your horse is prepared for the clinic. If your horse needs lunged, lunging will be permitted throughout the duration of the clinic in the Schooling Arena. On Friday, the Schooling Arena will be open from 12:00pm – 7:00pm. On Saturday and Sunday, the Schooling Arena will be open from 6:00am– 8:30am. From 8:30am – 8:45am, the Schooling Arena will be closed for watering and dragging. The Schooling Arena will be designated lunging only, weather permitting. If the clinic is to be held indoors due to inclement weather, lunging will be permitted before the start of the first session and during lunch hour in the indoor arena. We ask that riders execute caution when lunging and be respectful to all mounted riders.

**WARM-UP:** On Saturday and Sunday, Ring I and Ring II will be open for riding from 6:00am - 8:00am. From 8:00am - 8:30am these arenas will be closed for watering and dragging. The clinic will take place in Ring I. All mounted riders should warm up in Ring II. The Schooling Arena is for **lunging only**. Riders will be permitted to enter Ring I during schooling hours and after the conclusion of the previous session. There will be an hour intermission between Session One and Session Two to allow for lunch and schooling. Later, there will be a fifteen-minute intermission between Sessions Two and Session Three to allow horses and riders warm-up time. Should the clinic move indoors, schooling in the indoor would be permitted before the 9:00am start of the clinic each day, during lunch (11:00am – 12:00pm) and after the conclusion of the three clinic sessions. On Friday all arenas will be closed at 7:00pm. On Saturday and Sunday, all arenas will be closed to clinic participants at 6:00pm.

**PADDOCKS:** Limited turn out will be available at \$30/hour from 11:00am – 6:00pm. Please contact Dyann Herrmann at (724) 352-5366 to schedule your turnout. Times and paddocks will be available on a first come, first serve basis.

**NIGHT WATCH:** Night watch will be available at \$5.00 per horse per night. Night Watchers will check the horses between 9:00pm and 10:00pm. Watchers will make sure that all horses are comfortable and healthy as well as check water supply for each horse. If desired, Watchers can also give horses evening hay. Please specify in the provided section of the registration form whether or not you want your evening hay to be fed by the Watchers and in what quantity. Should an emergency occur, Watchers will contact the horse owner immediately. Should the owner be unavailable, the veterinarian listed on the stall card will be contacted.

**INDOOR ARENA:** The indoor riding arena will be closed to clinic participants unless the inclement weather moves the clinic indoors. This arena will be the designated “private” riding area for Horse On Course boarders. We do this out of respect for our boarders who are not participating in Horse On Course events and thank you for your cooperation.
