Entries

Entries will close on the Monday before each show. All horses/ponies entered must show proof of negative Coggins test before entry will be accepted. Likewise, all non-showing horses brought to the show facility must show proof of negative Coggins test to the show secretary upon arrival. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order.

Stabling

10x10 permanent wood stalls with door in permanent barn. 10x10 wooden outdoor stalls with doors. Stabling will be available at \$70.00/weekend, if pre-paid. The charge will be \$85.00 if fees are not received by Monday of the show week. Weekend stabling has priority over day stabling. Day stabling, if available, will be charged at \$35.00 per day/\$50.00 per night. Bedding will be available for purchase at \$8.00/bag. Requests for bedding should be included on your entry form. **STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE HELD WITHOUT PAYMENT.** Stall fees are not refundable. Reservations and fees must be received no later than Monday of the show week. Stalls will be available on Friday after 2:00PM. Please call DYANN to confirm stall reservations (724) 352-5366.

A Day Shipper fee of \$15.00 will be charged to all entries showing off their trailer. A special area will be designated for day shippers.

Parking

Please follow designated parking patterns and posted signs. Wet ground conditions may prohibit or limit parking on all areas of the show grounds. In an effort to keep the show grounds safe and accessible at all times we ask that you cooperate with the show staff and follow all designated parking patterns. **A special area will be designated for those showing off their trailer.**

Management

The horse show management reserves the right to itself to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors and to prohibit exhibition of entries, without claim for damages; to combine, add, divide, cancel or delete classes if insufficient entries warrant or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to add or substitute judges, or make any changes required by scheduling circumstances.

Class Descriptions

USDF Introductory A&B (Horse) classes are open to any rider showing a green horse in its first year of dressage competition. Training Level (Novice) is open to Juniors and Amateurs who have never won four blue ribbons at Training Level and have never shown at First Level or above. Riders may cross enter into Introductory or Open Training Tests. If entries warrant in the Training Level (Open) division, separate Junior and Adult ribbons will be awarded.

Attire

Riders must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the show ring. Please refer to the USEF rulebook for permissible tack and equipment.

Ring Sizes

A 20x40 meter competition arena will be used for all Walk-Trot tests. A 20x60 meter competition arena will be used for all other tests.

Scratches/Refunds

The Show Secretary should be notified immediately if you cannot attend the show so that people on the waiting list can be contacted. A full refund less office fees will be issued if the secretary is notified before the closing date. After closing date, one-half of entry fee less office fees with a veterinarian certificate within 3 days after the competition OR if ride times can be filled from waiting list will be issued. In the event of the cancellation of a competition due to extraordinary circumstances, refunds will be issued. No stall fees will be refunded.

Prizes

Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

High Score Ribbons will be presented for each test level for each day; Walk-Trot (Junior Rider), Walk-Trot (Amateur Rider), Walk-Trot (Horse), Training Level (Novice-Junior Rider), Training Level (Novice-Amateur Rider), Training Level (Open), First Level (Jr/Am Rider), First Level (Open) and Second Level. The awards will be calculated by averaging together the test scores per horse/rider combination per test level.

Hay, Feed and Bedding

Hay and grain will be available for purchase at the show facility. Bedding will also be available for purchase at \$8.00/bag. Feed, hay and bedding orders and payments may be made at the show office.

Dressage Equitation Classic

Horse On Course is proud to offer the Dressage Equitation Classic to our competitors. The competition is open to Junior and Adult/Amateur riders showing in the Walk-Trot and Training Level classes. There will be two divisions for the Dressage Classic, Walk-Trot and Training Level, each featuring a two-phase event. The first phase will be a dressage test and the second phase will be a dressage seat equitation class. Eligible riders may choose one of the following divisions:

Introductory Level Dressage Classic

The walk-trot division is open to all Junior and Adult/Amateur riders competing in the USDF Introductory Tests. All riders must show in at least one of the USDF walk-trot test at each show. Phase 1 of the classic is a dressage test (USDF Introductory Level - Test B). Phase 2 will be a group equitation class. The scores from each phase will be averaged together to determine the winners. Exclusive ribbons will be awarded through sixth place.

Class #7 Entry Fee: \$35.00

Training Level Dressage Classic

The Training Level division is open to all Junior and Adult/Amateur riders competing in the Training Level tests. All riders must show in at least Training Level Test 1 and 2 at each show. Phase 1 of the classic is a dressage test (Training Level Test 2). Phase 2 will be a group equitation class. The scores from each phase will be averaged together to determine the winners. Exclusive ribbons will be awarded through sixth place.

Class #16 Entry Fee: \$35.00

Please Note:

Horse/rider combinations are still eligible for the Dressage Classic even if previously entered in three dressage tests prior to competing in the Classic. Competitors in both divisions will perform their respective dressage tests and the dressage equitation flat phase will immediately follow.

PLEASE NOTE

- ❖ **Ride times will be posted on our website after 5:00pm on the Wednesday before each show.**
- ❖ Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Dogs are not permitted in the show office, indoor viewing area or concession area.
- ❖ No Smoking permitted inside the main building or around stabling areas.
- ❖ No alterations are to be made to the permanent stabling or other facilities by exhibitors.
- ❖ A processing fee of \$25.00 plus collection fees will be charged for any non-negotiable checks.
- ❖ All riders must wear protective headgear while mounted.
- ❖ All riders must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the ring.
- ❖ If the show is held indoors, an outdoor schooling area will be available and designated as such, weather and conditions permitting
- ❖ If the show is held indoors, an area inside the arena will be designated for spectators. Seating will not be provided.
- ❖ **All horses** brought to the facility (whether showing or not) are responsible for providing the show office with a signed entry form, current Coggins and payment of the Grounds Fee.
- ❖ **The English Rose (part of the Horse and the Hound Tack Shop)** will be serving delicious homemade food throughout the horse show.

Show Venue
